SWEET CITRUS BUNDLE

CARD 1 RECIPE



Daffadil Delight CS 5 1/2" x 8 1/2" scored at 4 1/4"

Basic Black CS 4" x 5 1/4"

Basic Black CS1 1 1/2" x 4 3/4"

Basic Black CS2 3/4" x 3 1/2"

Basic White CS (for embossing) 3 3/4" x 5"

Basic White CS (inside of card) 4" x 5 1/4"

Basic White CS (Stamp Greeting) 2 1/2" x 3 1/4"

Basic White Scraps to stamp Lemons, flowers and leaves

DSP 1 1/4" x 4 1/2"

DSP (for envelope) 2 1/2" x 6"

Black Ribbon for Bow

Memento Tuxedo Black Ink
Daffadil Delight Ink
Granny Apple Green Ink
Tombow Glue
Stampin' Dimensionals
Paper Trimmer
Stampin Cut Emboss Machine
Sweet Citrus Stamp Set
Sweet Citrus Hybrid Embossing Folder
Sweet Citrus Dies

Step 1:

Cut all cardstock/DSP to the dimensions listed above

Step 2:

Emboss the Basic White CS with the Sweet Citrus Hybrid Embossing Folder

Step 3:

Stamp you Lemon outline in Daffadil Delight, Stamp the inner/detailed stamp in daffadil delight and then cut and emboss your lemons with the dies and embossing folder in one pass.

Step 4:

Stamp your flowers on Basic White CS in Daffadil Delight and your leaves in Granny Apple Green and cut out with the dies

Step 5:

Stamp your Greeting on Basic White CS in Moment Tuxedo Black near the Bottom of the CS.

Step 6:

Glue you Basic Black CS and Embossed Basic White Cardstock together. Adhere to Daffadil Delight card base.

Step 7:

Glue your DSP and stamped sentiment to the Basic Black CS mat pieces. Then glue the DSP piece to the left of the card mat.

Step 8:

Assemble your Lemon pieces, flowers, leaves and ribbon to the top of the sentiment piece. Then adhere to card base overlapping the piece over the DSP. (Add black embellishments to the center of the flowers)

Step 9:

Add Basic White piece to inside of card (stamping prior to adhering). Add Lemon piece and leaves to the bottom right hand corner.

Step 10:

Add Tombow glue to the back flap of envelope; then add the DSP trimming around the flap to create a beautifully coordinated envelope to your card.
