TECHNIQUE – TRIPLE TIME STAMPING



MEASUREMENTS & SUPPLIES:

Basic White CS:

Card Base 5 1/2" x 8 1/2" scored at 4 1/4"

5" x 3 3/4"

2 3/4" x 2 3/4"

2 3/4" x 1 1/4"

Basic Black CS:

5 1/4" x 4"

3" x 3"

3" x 1 1/2"

Stamp Set: True Beauty Stamp Set

Inks: Momento Tuxedo Black, Pecan Pie, Poppy Parade and Old Olive

Tombow Glue

Glue Dots

Step 1:

Cut all cardstock to dimensions listed above

Step 2:

Place a glue dot (use your finger to lesson the adhesive stickiness so that when you remove the piece it won't tear the cardstock) on the Basic White square and the Basic White sentiment piece.

Step 3:

Place your Basic White Square piece on the 5" x 3 3/4" piece. (mine is left centered)

Step 4:

Place your Basic White sentiment piece partially overlapping the square.

Step 5:

Stamp your sentiment in Momento Tuxedo Black first. Then Stamp your flower in Poppy Parade ensuring it is stamped over all three (3) pieces of basic white cardstock; then stamp your stem and leaf in Old Olive ensuring it is stamped over all three pieces. Lastly stamp with Pecan Pie the flower branch ensuring you cover as much of the three pieces of basic white as possible. (When using this technique, you will have gaps in the stamping---THAT IS OK!)

Step 6:

Pull your sentiment piece and the square piece off the 5" x 3 3/4" piece. Adhere the Basic Black mats and reassemble the card. Make sure to line up all the stamping.

This was the first technique I ever learned and to this day; I love the results it gives!
