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MINI NOTEBOOK TUTORIAL



MEASUREMENTS:

DSP Outside: 6" x 9 1/4"

scored on 9 ¼" side at: ½", 4 ¼", 5 1/8", 8 3/4" scored on 6" side at: 3/8" on each end

DSP Inside: 4 ¾" x 7 ½"

Chipboard (up cycle and reuse the chipboard that comes in your Stampin' Up Speciality papers or your Paper Pumpkin Boxes)

Two pieces cut at 5" x 3.5" One piece cut at 5" x ¾"

Ribbon of choice: 24"

Optional: If adding a pocket to inside front use a

coordinating DSP or CS that measures 3 7/8" x 2 5/8" scored

at ¼" on three sides.

If adding mats to front and back measurements are:

 $5^{\prime\prime}$ x 3 $1\!\!\!/2^{\prime\prime}$ and 4 $1\!\!\!/4^{\prime\prime}$ x 3 $1\!\!\!/4^{\prime\prime}$

If adding Spine Mats the measurements are:

5" x 3/4" and 4 ¾" x ½"

Chipboard

Paper Trimmer, 152392 Bone Folder, 102300 Take Your Pick Tool, 144107 Tear and Tape Adhesive, 154031

Tombow Glue, 110755 Paper Snips, 103579







STEP 1	STEP 2	STEP 3
Cut, score and burnish the DSP for the outside. Remove the corner pieces and miter cut as shown above.	Glue the chipboard as shown in picture. Make sure to leave space as shown. Fold and adhere the outside edges over the chipboard pieces. Fold Ribbon in half, starting in the middle of the spine chipboard and working to outer edges adhere to chipboard.	Using DSP for inside, add tear and tape to all four edges. Peel back the tape (as shown in picture) about a third of the way. This helps to get the inside just right. Once you have placement, pull the tabs you created off and finish adhering to base. Burnish all sides and use bone folder to crease the space between spine. Glue Dollar Tree Notebook to right side of book ensuring it is lined up against spine, top and bottom and tie your ribbon in a bow.
